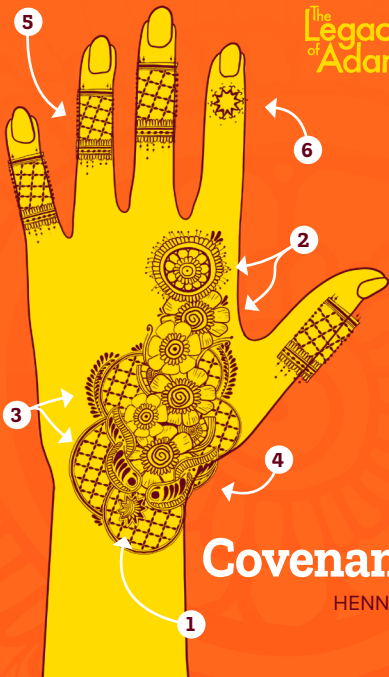
HENNA INSTRUCTIONS

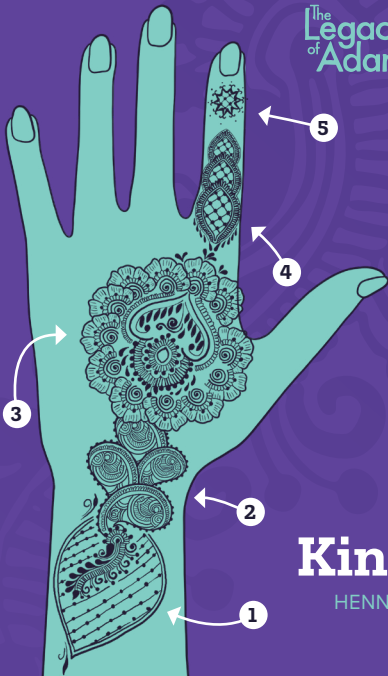
HENNA INSTRUCTIONS

4. Draw a ram's horns to illustrate the sacrifice.

HENNA INSTRUCTIONS

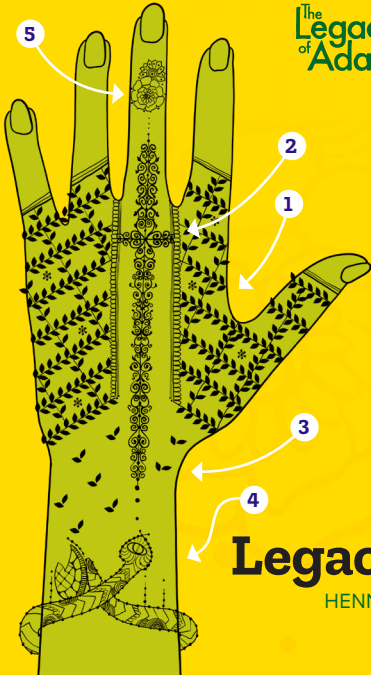
1. Draw a leaf to represent the remnants of King David's rule, serving as the core symbol.

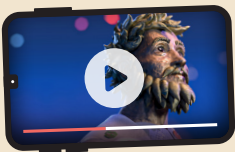
