

The Episodes

The 27 episodes takes us through the Bible stories from fall to redemption, and are divided into 5 seasons:



Creation (3 episodes)

Adam and Eve are with God in the Garden of Eden, enjoying bliss. However, they disobey

God's will and are expelled from the garden and His presence. God promises to rectify the issue.

The Covenant (6 episodes)

Abraham and Sarah follow God's will, and Abraham is promised a vast lineage from which a savior will emerge to address the issue introduced in the first tale.



The King (6 episodes)

The shepherd boy David defeats Goliath, earning hero status. Is he the prophesied savior?

God promises David a descendant who will reign forever and solve the initial problem.



The Prince of Peace (5 episodes)

Jesus is born in Bethlehem, fulfilling parts of the prophecies. Yet, can this child resolve the grand dilemma?



The Legacy (7 episodes)

We follow Jesus in his final days in Jerusalem, witnessing His death and resurrection. By dying and rising, Jesus resolves the problem from the first story, allowing humanity to be in God's presence again.



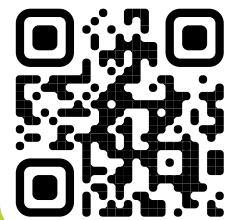

The Legacy of Adam

A free faith-based teaching resource for parents, Sunday school teachers, preachers and groups.

How does it work?

A simple guide for Sunday schools:



1. Give a card

Everyone receives a card connected to the episode one week before the lesson. Their home assignment is to watch an episode using the link on the card.



2. Watch an episode

Either the child has seen this as a home assignment, or you watch this together. Each episode is about 12 minutes long.



3. What did you notice?

Let the children retell the story in their own words. There are no wrong answers.



4. Talk about value

Each episode is made to help you talk about what we call “The 3 Big Values”:

- What is true?
- What breaks?
- How does God respond?



5. Read the sermon

We provide a sermon relevant to the current episode. Short. Focused. To the point. About 10 minutes of “aha”.



6. Use the coloring sheets

Each episode has its own character available as a color sheet.



7. Ask questions from the cards

Use the questions to connect the story to real life. What will you do differently this week because of the story you saw?
